## 1. Privacy Policy

We are committed to safeguarding the privacy of our website visitors. In this policy we explain when and how your personal information is processed on the AcceptEmail website (<http://www.acceptemail.com>).

Your use of this website signifies your consent to us collecting and using personal data about in accordance with this policy.

## 2. Information Collection and Use

We may collect, store and use the following kinds of personal information:

- Information about visitors' computer and about visits to and use of this website (including but not limited to the IP address, geographical location, browser type and version, operating system, referral source, length of visit, page views and website navigation paths;
- Any other personal information that visitors choose to send to us (for example via the contact form).

In case a visitor has sent an AcceptEmail via the demo functionality within our website, the visitor is also a Recipient, in that case the [privacy policy for Recipients of an AcceptEmail](#) is also applicable.

## 3. Third parties

Hyperlinks – For the convenience of its users, AcceptEmail has incorporated hyperlinks to third party websites on its own website. The privacy policy of these third parties applies to these websites. AcceptEmail is in no way responsible for the content of these websites and any data collected on them.

## 4. Compliance with Laws

AcceptEmail greatly values the protection of personal data. Personal data are therefore treated with the greatest possible care and are secured. In all cases, AcceptEmail complies with the demands set in the 'Wet bescherming persoonsgegevens'. Data provided by website visitors will never be passed on to third parties.

## 5. Cookies

The AcceptEmail website (<http://www.acceptemail.com>) makes limited use of cookies (small files that are sent to the browser and are saved on the hard drive that register how and when a website visitor uses a website).

Cookies that are used on our websites help AcceptEmail to provide customised services and information. We use cookies on all of our websites to gather information on how and when pages in our websites are visited, what our users' technology preferences are and whether our websites are functioning properly.

The website uses the following cookies:

- Google Analytics: This cookie allows us to see information on visitor activities including, but not limited to page views, source and time spent on the website. The information is depersonalised and is displayed as numbers, meaning it can not be traced back to individuals and/or location. This will help to protect visitor privacy. Using Google Analytics we can see what content is popular on our website, and strive to give visitors more of the things they are interested in reading and watching;
- Social sharing cookies: We use social sharing buttons for services including, but not limited to, Twitter, LinkedIn, and Google+. These allow visitors to share pages with their friends via those networks. Whilst visitors will in most cases be asked to login to use these services, this process is handled directly by the social sharing providers and their databases and servers. These sites may also monitor the usage of these buttons, through the use of external tracking codes that are required to run the buttons on our website;
- Session cookies: Session cookies enable the website to keep track of a visitor's movement from page to page so they don't get asked for the same information already given to the site. These cookies allow visitors to proceed through many pages of the site quickly and easily without having to authenticate or reprocess each new area visited.
